

Press Operator (216838)

Must have strong manufacturing experience preferably in a metals environment.

Perform highly skilled operations utilizing press forging equipment.

Must be able to accurately program forge furnaces to appropriate temperature and be able to monitor its temperature to assure accurate temperature tolerances are achieved and maintained

Must perform rudimentary, in process inspection of forging at interim levels of the manufacturing process.

Maintain attendant production records for the cell.

Must assure that daily inspections of cell related equipment (forklifts, etc.) are properly performed and documented.

Must assure that all levels of communication with the Maintenance Department and Operations Supervisor occurs for any situations that arise

Must assure that all 5S standards for the cell are maintained

Must be able to demonstrate the ability to read and interpret, in English, process sheets, shop orders and instructions.

Must be able to demonstrate appropriate hand/eye coordination to accurately visually align parts in ring mills, and measure forgings.

May be required to wear a respirator.

Must demonstrate the ability to be certified by Alcoa EHS and OSHA standards to operate a forklift.
