The Social Studies Teacher is responsible for providing a success-oriented learning and/or skill building experience for designated students. The candidate for this position must possess strong behavior management skills, as well as the ability to differentiate instruction in order to meet the needs of the youth that we serve. Candidates also must be able to work effectively as a member of the treatment team.

The person in this position is an adult role model for students and colleagues in all behaviors including communication, hygiene, and appearance, management of self, response to stress and challenges, and in the demonstration of professional relationships with others. As a member of an interdisciplinary team and as a child advocate, the Social Studies Teacher demonstrates (on the job) a broad understanding of students' educational, social and personal challenges and capabilities, and also demonstrates a commitment to quality through the effective use of resources.

Requirements: Bachelor's degree is required, Master's degree is preferred. NYS Certification in Special Education (7-12) or Social Studies is required. Both certifications are preferred. Candidates must have valid NY State Driver's License and must meet agency driving standards.
