The deburrer role requires experience working with micro-machined medical parts to inspect finished products to ensure they comply with legal, organizational or client specifications. These specs normally ensure parts or products fit the needs of clients or customers and ensure safe usage. A variety of tools are commonly used in this process, including gauges and micrometers.

Additionally, deburrers check machinery to make any necessary adjustments when problems arise.
