We are seeking an experienced Cutting Machine Operator to set up and operate cutting and/or sheeting machine equipped with rotary or reciprocating blades to cut material such as cloth, paper, paperboard, cellophane, or plastic into sheets by performing the following duties.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Follows direction for daily cutting plan assigned by department lead.
- Turns cutter machine on and allows a few seconds for machine to calibrate.
- Readjusts machine, if needed, to ensure specified starting cut is correct.
- Observes operation of machine to detect malfunctions such as jamming, wrinkling, or tearing of material.
- Reads work order to determine dimensions of sheets to be cut.
- Reads ruler to accurately measure materials.
- If cutting clear vinyl, set program.
- Cuts material to size required.
- Place finished cut material in its proper place.
- Replaces worn cutting blades.
- Maintains neat and organized work area.
- Backs up sheeter operator.

Education and/or Experience

High school diploma or general education degree (GED); or one to three months related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.

Prior cutting machine experience preferred.

Language Skills

Ability to read and comprehend simple instructions, short correspondence, and memos. Ability to complete production logs. Ability to effectively communicate with co-workers in one-on-one and small group situations.

Mathematical Skills

Ability to read a standard ruler, add and subtract two digit numbers and to multiply and divide with 10's and 100's. Ability to perform these operations using units of volume.
