- Professional Development Ready Software
- Students have goals and dreams and don't have the information on how to get there
- Prepares youth for their first work experience
- Gamified platform
- Currently in use at UPrep
- Students were more prone to burn bridges- will help with the tracking of communication skills
- Software provides a student profile that maps out a career plan
 - Allows students to complete self-assessments
 - Document every work experience
 - Modules are taught by professionals
 - Can add tasks to student files to help build skills and for areas of improvement
- Automates resumes for students
 - Can generate a resume- 1st of its kind to generate an employability profile
 - Checks rather students are ready and evaluate what they need to work on
 - Adding skills before being accepted into an opportunity
- Pointii Academy
 - Professionals sharing tips
 - 300+ videos of professionals within the selected career field
 - Letters of recommendations can be uploaded and kept on file
 - Students will receive points based on what they complete on the website

- More points- better opportunities
- Students like incentives- immediate gratification
- What does a partnership look like with Pointii?
 - Organizations will have the option to have their own partners(employers)
 - Will be able to track each youth enrolled experiences and hours
 - Youth can create career plans and generate points
 - Can take part in experiences to strengthen a required skill
 - Work-based learning dash board
 - Career connections-students can apply directly
 - Software cuts out the ambiguity with hiring, especially for in-demand fields
- Knowing how many students ready, self-aware organizations/ schools are able to view
- Support to educators-
 - Can send a digital resume
- Benefits
 - Knowing who students are
 - Use Pointii to know what skills they can strengthen
 - From students- looking at a career plan
 - Works with ERYAC- have been for the past 9 months
 - Is more updated than Career Zone
- Charge schools for service- for profit organization
 - Currently in 9 RCSD, 4 Charter Schools, Ohio, Pennsylvania., will be rolling out to other areas
- Starts at 6th grade
- Follow NYS career plan
- Teachers inputting data into system, youth inputting
- Employers don't have access to the site
- Make it easier to be the first person- to verify youth have the skills
 - Communication skills, and why, etc.
 - Fact check skills before making the connection to employers
- Portfolio brief case- students and educators putting information into it to use with employers
- Printable at anytime
- Student career plans- no prior work experience
 - Employers see what they believe their skills are and how they value themselves

CDOS, Rhonda Neal

- Work Based learning- Executive Director of Career Pathways with RCSD
- Professional Credit- PD credit
- Registered Programs- tied to a course, tracked in the system, can pull data at the end of the year
- Unregistered- students have more opportunities out in the field to gain work experience
- In addition to and are not to replace Regents Diploma

- NYS student can cross the stage with CDOS Commencement Credential
- SMS- tracked on student transcript
 - Passed 1 social studies, 5th regents- option to take 1 of the work readiness exams
 - Skills USA Exam- aligns with career financial management
 - Pointii serves as a supplemental tool to track
- Recognized by the Board of Regents
 - Student completes career plan, CTE course- showing met the requirements
 - Counselors are supposed to work from the 9th grade on career plans with students
 - 54 supervised work experiences, 216 required work hours
 - Equal to 2 CTE credits
 - CDOS credential to show you are entry level employable
- GEWEP- General Work Experience Program
 - Online computer work- knowing what it means to be in the workforce
- 2 central work base coordinators in RCSD- to monitor it across the district

Option 1

- is for the overage under-credited student,
- Traditionally been done for students with disabilities
- Different pathways for students with disabilities- graduating with local diploma

Option 2

- Most popular
- CDOS 4+1- struggling with 1 of the regents
- Require the career plan
- Students who want to come back later to get a local diploma
- Take a Skills USA exam
- Registered programs- take an online course
- Curriculum associated with GWEP
- Unregistered- usually assisted by guidance counselor, other school administrators
- Service Learning- projects completed for business partners, these are where the supervised work experience hours are acquired- 54 hours requirements
